2. Reporting and Registration

- 2.1. You should report to the college on.....
- 2.2. You should report during working hours; that are from 8:00 am to 4:00 p.m. No. student will beat ended before or after office hours.

- 2.3. On arrival, you will be required to prove to the bursar/Accountant that you have paid the fees by showing the original pay in slip to the bursar. Failure to that you will not be accepted to join the Institute.
- 2.4. Read the whole instructions carefully. You will only be allowed to register for studies after fulfilling the requirements as indicated in all sections of the joining instructions.

3. Accommodation and Meals

- 3.1. Hostels are available for both Boys and Girls at cost of 200,000/= at each semester.
- 3.2. Those that will stay in our Hostel (i.e Boarding Scholars) will be required to have extra money for breakfast, lunch and supper which will be provided in the Institute Cafeteria or any other cafeteria around the Institute.
- 3.3. The Institute will not give any daily allowances to students; you have to discuss with your sponsor on additional money you will need for daily expenses.

4. Training Fee Applicable for the Academic Year 2025/2026

- 4.1. Should there be an unavoidable circumstance that would require revision of fees; they may be revised from time to time without prior notice.
- 4.2 Revised fee structure will be applicable to the new intake as well as for continuing students.
- 4.3 Fees are payable in full at the beginning of each year or into four installments as shown to the table below
- 4.4 No student will be allowed to carry forward part of the fee into the following installment, semester or academic year.
- 4.5 The training fee will not be refunded or exchanged to another student's bill after a student has been registered with the Institute.

5. Additional Institute Requirements.

6.1 Original Certificates

You should bring the original form IV certificates or result slip from National Examination Council of Tanzania or any other certificate relevant for this course from recognized institution.

6.2 Uniforms.

- Institute uniforms are included in student's direct costs. They will be provided after registration.
- Female student should come with black shoes and white socks
- Male student should come with 2pairs of Black or dark-tan shoes, white socks and two white short sleeved shirts.
- Sandals and other types of shoes are not allowed to be worming any of the Institute building, except in the students' hostel

6.3 Medical Examination.

You should do medical examination and bring a certified copy from a registered medical practitioner practicing in a registered hospital showing that you are medically fit to pursue a 3 years course. Use the form attached with this joining instruction.

Do not cheat; if the Institute proves that you have cheated in filling the medical examination forms, you will be discontinued even after registration.
